

**WHAT:** We are excited to offer a multitude of STEM camps to Savannah Chatham County students across the district! Seat numbers are limited and on a first come first serve basis.

COST: Each camp costs \$75 and two sessions run daily. Session (A) running from 9 am-11:45 am and Session (B) running from 12:15 pm-3:00 pm. Students may choose to take two sessions each week at a total cost of \$150.

#### **MARVELous Movie Props**

In the course of Marvelous Movie Props, students will be introduced to prop making, function and purpose. The students will learn the history of iconic superheroes and how artists use the elements and principles of art, color theory and iconography to create world recognized heroes. Using a variety of three dimensional materials, tools and techniques the students will create a functional Superhero original prop of their very own!
